Calisia is a Type Design project by Radek Łukasiewicz. Initial sketches of the letter shapes were created back in 2014. The idea was a reaction to overuse of news oriented typefaces like Times. Calisia is inspired by the warm feeling of craftsmanship combined with compact appearance. Calisia performs well in a narrow column setting. Thanks to an extensive character set and selection of weights the family is suitable for building extensive systems and type hierarchies.

What's so special about the family?

The family, consists of 10 styles, 5 weights with accompanying italics. The character set contains extended latin and cyrillic and small caps. You can choose from 4 sets of figures: oldstyle, lining, tabular oldstyle and tabular lining. Calisia also contains superiors and inferiors. The special feature of Calisia is “petit” which is a special set of lowercase characters dedicated for setting very small type sizes. “Petit” letters have increased x-height, more robust construction and shorter extenders. You can access them by turning on “stylistic set 1” open type feature.

Pierogi, also known as varenyky, are filled dumplings of Central and Eastern European origin. They are made by wrapping pockets of unleavened dough around a savory or sweet filling and cooking them in boiling water. These dumplings are popular in Slavic (Polish, Slovak, Ukrainian, Russian, Belarusian), Baltic (Latvian, Lithuanian) and other Eastern European cuisines (such as Romanian), where they are known under local names. Pierogi are especially associated with Poland, Ukraine, and Slovakia, where they are considered national dishes. Pierogi are often semi-circular, but triangular and rectangular ones are also found. Typical fillings include potato, sauerkraut, ground meat, cheese, and fruits. The dumplings may be served with a topping, such as melted butter, sour cream, or fried onion, or combinations of

An exhibition of approximately 55 works including prints augmented by drawings, a photograph, and sculpture, is on view through December 4 in the third-floor Sachs Galleries of The Museum of Modern Art. The exhibition, directed by Howardena Pindell, Associate Curator, Department of Prints and Illustrated Books, is drawn from the Museum Collection, consisting of work done in the 1920s, '30s, and '40s by members of the Abstraction-Creation, Art Non-Figuratif group, an international

In 1930 or early '31, a group of artists concerned with aspects of abstraction including Theo van Doesburg, leader of Art Concret, put forth a proposal for an international union of abstract artists. Abstraction-Creation, Art Non-Figuratif was founded February 15, 1931,

and between 1932 and 1936 published five issues of their annual periodical, which was used as a means of attracting new members. Artists were invited to submit photographs with accompanying statements, some choosing to offer earlier work from the 1920s, as well as images of current work. The group also held a series of exhibitions showing members work on a rotating basis. An editorial appearing in the first issue of Abstraction-Creation stated that artists whose work contained recognizable

Kazimir Malevich, an artist as influential as he was radical, cast a long shadow over the history of modern art.
